## **NURTURING NEW BELIEVERS PROGRAM**

## 1. Welcome and Orientation:

#### A. Welcome Session:

- Introduce new believers to the church community.
- Share the church's mission, vision, and core beliefs.
- Provide an overview of the nurturing program.

#### **B.** Orientation Materials:

 Provide a welcome packet including a Bible, Church Hymnal, Lumakad kasama si Hesus, Pagkalinga sa mga bagong kaanid ng Iglesia, a church directory, a calendar of events, and an introduction to Adventist beliefs and practices.

## 2. Personal Spiritual Growth:

## A. Bible Study Classes:

- Weekly Bible study sessions focusing on foundational topics like salvation, grace, faith, and the teachings of Jesus.
- Use resources like "Steps to Christ" and "The Desire of Ages" by Ellen G. White.

#### **B. Personal Devotion:**

- Encourage daily personal devotion and Bible reading (Using Lumakad kasama si Hesus).
- · Provide devotionals and Bible reading plans.

## 3. Doctrinal Instruction:

## A. Fundamental Beliefs Class:

- A series of classes covering the 28 Fundamental Beliefs of the Seventh-day Adventist Church.
- Interactive discussions and Q&A sessions.

### **B. Sabbath School:**

 Encourage regular attendance at Sabbath School for systematic Bible study and fellowship.

## A. Small Groups:

- Form small groups or home Bible study groups for deeper connection and support.
